

FOLLOWING GODS PATH #3

1. The greatness of His plan calls for His greatness, so let's put a demand on His greatness to supply and fulfill His great plan.

A. Ephesians 2:10 We are God's [own] handiwork (His workmanship), recreated in Christ Jesus, [born anew] that we may do those good works which God predestined (planned beforehand) for us [taking paths which He prepared ahead of time], that we should walk in them [living the good life which He prearranged and made ready for us to live].”(AMPC)

b. God has already made your life good so you can live in this evil world.

C. He has A path for you and everything we need is on our paths for good success. Healing; Deliverance; Prosperity; wisdom, Victory.

D. We must stay on the path he has prepared not wandering off our path

E. We must remember to appropriate everything we need on our path requires faith

F. Two kinds of Faith – Real Faith Only Comes By The Word Of God- Needs No Outside Evidence To Believe It. Sense Knowledge Faith Needs Something Outside The Word To Believe It.

G. God answers your need before your need shows up in your life because he has already walked your path

H. When a man is following God's plan for his life, he doesn't get disturbed if God's plan leads him to a place of need, for he knows the supply is just as present as the need.

I. Philippians 4:19 But my God shall supply all your need according to his riches in glory by Christ Jesus.

J. Philippians 4:19 And my God will liberally supply (fill to the full) your every need according to His riches in glory in Christ Jesus. (AMPC)

K. Anytime God tells us to do something, He also gives us the grace to accomplish it. Contained in that grace are the wisdom, the ability, and all the resources we will need to accomplish it.

L. That's why we can start with “nothing” when God tells us to do something because the supply is not of us, but it's of the grace that comes with the greatness of that plan.

M. God will tell us to do things we ourselves don't have the money for because He is the Provider and our great Source – He intends to fund it!

N. Anything God has told you to do is too great for your own resources. That's why the Word says that “My God shall supply...” not your resources.

O. Don't dismiss yourself from the greatness of God just because you looked at your resources. God is not looking for your sponsorship – He is looking for your faith and your obedience to His plan.

2. Lets make sure we have the foundation of faith in our lives or we will never fulfill the plan for our lives.

A. Hosea 4:6 My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge: because thou hast rejected knowledge, I will also reject thee, that thou shalt be no priest to me: seeing thou hast forgotten

the law of thy God, I will also forget thy children.

B. The devil cannot destroy us but ignorance can destroy us.

C.

Psalms 81:10-11 I am the Lord thy God, which brought thee out of the land of Egypt: open thy mouth wide, and I will fill it. **11** But my people would not hearken to my

voice; and Israel would none of me

D. When God says he

brought them out. They were out.

E. Someone who

is out has a work to do. Your mouth has to do the work.

F. Open your

mouth wide and speak large things.

G. God was talking

to people who have been in slavery for over 400 years. When you are in slavery you are not opening your mouth to ask for anything. Nothing belongs to you. You do not even belong to yourself. So, its easy to fall in the trap of talking and thinking like you did before.

H.

When one opens his mouth wide it's a consistent speaking. God did not say figure it out; calculate it out but Open your Mouth.

I The bigness that

God has for your life begins with an open mouth. Gods part is to bring us out our part is to open our Mouths wide

J. Now notice in **verse 10**

Gods part is to fill it.

K. You cannot fill it all you do is

open your mouth wide and he will meet it with fullness.

L. We do not open our mouths tom our circumstances or fear or worry or doubt He can only fill what you speak about him

M. **vs 11** Our

part is to listen or teachable. To many believers are not teachable. They already know it.

N. You know this is the old

covenant but we have a better covenant so what is ours is better than this.

O. **Colossians 1:13** Who hath delivered us from the power of darkness, and hath translated us into the kingdom of his dear Son

P. Anything

that is of darkness is none of yours. Not being able to pay your bills does not fir you! Not being able to receive your total healing form any disease or illness does not fit you.

Q. You do not ever have to get delivered you

are delivered NOW. The power of darkness has no authority over me

R. What you are delivered out of will not go into effect till you Open your mouth to it.

S. The bolder you say it the bigger the revelation. A constrained mouth limits God

3. **We do not receive from God base on what he can do. We receive from God bases on what we Believe.**

A. God cannot

help you if you do not open your mouth and says what he says.

B. **2 Timothy 2:15** Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth

C. We do not read our bibles to earn it. We read our bibles to find out what is already ours.

D. Everything in the

Kingdom is already yours. Everything heaven has is already yours. However, Its waiting for your mouth to show up.

E. You may ask how long do I say

it? Buts it's how long do you want it. We are to have a lifestyle of saying.

F. **Luke 15:11-32** **20.** And he arose, and came to his father. But when he was yet a great way off, his father saw him, and had compassion, and ran, and fell on his neck, and kissed him. **21** And the son said unto him, Father, I have sinned against heaven, and in thy sight, and am no more worthy to be called thy son. **22** But the father said to his servants, Bring forth the best robe, and put it on him; and put a ring on his hand, and shoes on his feet: **23** And bring hither the fatted calf, and kill it; and let us eat, and be merry: **24** For this my son was dead, and is alive again; he was lost, and is found. And they began to be merry. **25** Now his elder son was in the field: and as he came and drew nigh to the house, he heard musick and dancing. **26** And he called one of the servants and asked what these things meant. **27** And he said unto him, Thy brother is come; and thy father hath killed the fatted calf, because he hath received him safe and sound. **28** And he was angry, and would not go in: therefore came his father out, and intreated him. **29** And he answering said to his father, Lo, these many years do I serve thee, neither transgressed I at any time thy commandment: and yet thou never gavest me a kid, that I might make merry with my friends: **30** But as soon as this thy son was come, which hath devoured thy living with harlots, thou hast killed for him the fatted calf. **31** And he said unto him, Son, thou art ever with me, and all that I have is thine. **32** It was meet that we should make merry, and be glad: for this thy brother was dead, and is alive again; and was lost, and is found.

G. You can see how the father had compassion and went out to meet his son and God put things on him.

H. Do not wait for God to put it on you that's what a wayward son needs. **I.** A wayward son is under a sense of condemnation. He is not bold to come back to the father and take hold of things. This son's faith was injured because he did not understand his relationship with his Father so his father had to put it on him.

J. Don't Wait For God To Give You Your Money; Don't Wait For God To Dump Your Healing On You.

K. Just open your mouth wide and take the position that belongs to the elder son

L. **vs 31** And the father said to him, Son, you are always with me, and all that is mine is yours. (AMPC)

M. We do not try this we receive. We open our mouths wide.

N. Remember **Romans 10:10** For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation. **O.** faith has to be in two places in our heart and in our mouths

P. We should get up in the morning saying All that is yours is mine; When you pay your bills all that you have is mine. This is a lifestyle.

Q. **Matthew 8:17** That it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Esaias the prophet, saying, Himself took our infirmities, and bare our sicknesses. **R.** Notice "that it might be fulfilled- If healing is not being fulfilled you are not speaking it; If your finances are not being fulfilled you are not speaking it.

S. the

unspoken goes unfulfilled. The more you speak it the sooner it is fulfilled

T. The more you say it the more you have; the less you say it the less you have.

4. You are in another system. You are not limited to the system of the world around you. We do not live like we use to we live supernatural.

A. **Mark 9:23** Jesus said unto him, If thou canst believe, all things are possible to him that believeth.

B. We live in all things are possible! There is no such Word as Impossible in heaven.

C. When God brought the Israelites out Egypt there was not one feeble one among them. God told them ask Egyptians for their wealth and the Israelites walk out with all the wealth of Egypt -400 years back pay in one day.

D. God wants our desires to be extensive because God is rich enough to meet all your needs.

E. **Luke 17:6** And the Lord said, If ye had faith as a grain of mustard seed, ye might say unto this sycamine tree, Be thou plucked up by the root, and be thou planted in the sea; and it should obey you.

F. Focus on your saying not the size of your Faith. G. the plan for your life is so great and its going to need fulfillment to fulfill it. This involves a wide-open mouth. God is giving you a divine invitation to open your mouth.

G. 1 **John 4:4** Ye are of God, little children, and have overcome them: because greater is he that is in you, than he that is in the world.

H. There Is A Genius In You. Listen To The Holy Ghost. Be Teachable.

I. you can open your mouth wide when you recognize and agree with what the Spirit is saying.

K. Hebrews 4:2 For unto us was the gospel preached, as well as unto them: but the word preached did not profit them, not being mixed with faith in them that heard it.

L. Its not enough God said it You have to mix your faith with what Gods says and open your mouth.

M. Now practice this by having personal faith projects
