

## THURSDAY BIBLE STUDY-HE HEALS ALL

1. **God's WORD declares Jesus "healed them all"** **A.**

**Matthew 12:15** But when Jesus knew it, he withdrew himself from thence: and great multitudes followed him, and he healed them all; **B.**

**Psalms 107:20** He sent His word and healed them, And delivered them from their destructions. **C. Psalms 107:20**

**17**Some of us were such fools, bringing on ourselves sorrow and suffering all because of our sins. **18**Sick and feeble, unable to stand the sight of food, we drew near to the gates of death. **19**Then we cried out, "Lord, help us! Rescue us!" And he did! **20.**God spoke the words "Be healed," and we were healed, delivered from death's door! **21**So lift your hands and give thanks to God for his marvelous Kindness and for his miracles of mercy for those he loves! (Passion)

**D.** Gods love is so powerful. It's his Love that he desires no sickness & disease.

**E. Psalm 145:8-9** The Lord is gracious, and full of compassion; slow to anger, and of great mercy. **9** The Lord is good to all: and his tender mercies are over all his works. **F. Psalm 145:16**

Thou openest thine hand, and satisfiest the desire of every living thing (God is not tightfisted, but open handed) **G.** He is the Healer; He's the prosperity of life. See yourself with what you asked for.

**H.** If you say, "I'm too far gone to receive healing," that's not true. You are still breathing, so you're not too far gone. **I.** Jesus

healed when He was on earth, and He is still ready to heal today. Receive it.

**J. Make this declaration:** *"The Healer is in the house today. Today is my receiving day. I'm supposed to be well. I'm Supposed to prosper in all things. Thank You, Jesus, for being my Healer.*
2. **The Holy Spirit will teach you from God's WORD. Refuse to speak words of criticism and judgment. Jesus healed in response to faith, so speak faith.**

**A.** The Holy Spirit will teach you from God's WORD. We want to learn and receive God's best by His Spirit.

**B.** In **Mark 5** there are some things that are extremely important!

**C.** Jairus implored Jesus to come and heal his daughter. He said, **Mark 5:23** "My little daughter lieth at the point of death: I pray thee, come and lay thy hands on her, that she may be healed; and she shall live" **D.** That's quite a statement of faith. Jesus went with Jairus. Jesus didn't say, "You're going to have to repent" or "You are going to have to keep this problem a while longer because God is trying to teach you something." That is not in the Bible.

**E.** Get healed first and then let The LORD correct you. Remember to forgive

**F.** Jesus healed in response to faith. On the way to Jairus' home, a certain woman with an issue of blood touched Jesus' clothes to be healed. Jairus had to wait while the woman told Jesus her story of her 12 years of illness and her

miraculous healing.

**G.** Jairus had said what he wanted. He wisely didn't speak again even when someone came along and said, "Thy daughter is dead: why troublest thou the Master any further?" (Mark 5:35).

**H.** Jesus encouraged Jairus, "Be not afraid, only believe" (Mark 5:36). Jairus dealt with death by stopping the fear. He didn't lose his faith.

**I.** When they got to Jairus' house, Jesus was ready to release His faith. He said, "The damsel is not dead, but sleepeth" (Mark 5:39).

**J.** HE then disassociated with those who were not in faith, (Mark 5:40) And they laughed him to scorn. But when he had put them all out, he taketh the father and the mother of the damsel, and them that were with him, and entereth in where the damsel was lying.

**Mark 5:40 TPT** Then everyone began to ridicule and make fun of him. But he threw them all outside. Then he took the child's father and mother and his three disciples and went into the room where the girl was lying.

**K.** Jesus spoke words of faith and healing. He told the daughter to arise, and she was healed.

**L.** Jesus taught us to speak faith. **Mark 11:23-25** "For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith. Therefore, I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them. And when ye stand praying, forgive".

**Mark 11:23-25 TPT** Listen to the truth I speak to you: Whoever says to this mountain with great faith and does not doubt, 'Mountain, be lifted up and thrown into the midst of the sea,' and believes that what he says will happen, it will be done. This is the reason I urge you to boldly believe for whatever you ask for in prayer—be convinced that you have received it and it will be yours. And whenever you stand praying, if you find that you carry something in your heart against another person, release him and forgive him so that your Father in heaven will also release you and forgive you of your faults.

**M.** You don't just speak in faith when you need something. It's what you think, say and do all the time that brings results. You will become what you think all the time.

**N.** Make this declaration: "I'm supposed to be healed today. I'm supposed to be well. Jesus is my Healer."

**O.** *Father, I want to speak faith just like Jesus did when He was on earth. Teach me through Your WORD and through the guidance of the Holy Spirit to grow my faith, so that my words have the power of God to stop every problem and defeat every enemy. Thank You. In Jesus' Name. Amen.*

### 3. Most Christian people do not know what they are redeemed from.

**A.** We are redeemed from the curse of the Law (**Galatians 3:13**).

**B.** The Old Covenant was established in the blood of circumcision. The New Covenant is established in the blood of Jesus.

**C.** You are BLESSED with faithful Abraham. **Galatians 3:14** That the blessing of Abraham might come on the Gentiles through Jesus Christ; that we might receive the promise of the Spirit through faith.

**D.** Christ has redeemed us from the curse of the Law, so there's nothing left but THE BLESSING.

**E.** The curse is threefold: spiritual death/sickness and disease/poverty.

**F.** THE BLESSING is three-fold: spiritual life (when you get born again which includes the indwelling of the Holy Spirit)/divine health or healing and miracles/outstanding prosperity.

**G.** God's promises of BLESSING will work for anyone who will believe and receive them. We receive THE BLESSING of Abraham by faith.

**H.** **Galatians 3:16**

Now to Abraham and his seed were the promises made. He saith not, And to seeds, as of many; but as of one, And to thy seed, which is Christ. (Abraham's seed (singular) was Christ Jesus. You are all the children of God by faith in Christ Jesus (**Galatians 3:26**).

**I.** "And if ye be Christ's, then are ye Abraham's seed, and heirs according to the promise" (**Galatians 3:29**).

**J.** Declare it: "I've been redeemed from the curse." Sickness is a curse of the Law, and it does not belong to ME.

**K.** Healing is not a reward; it is a property. We own it. Healing was bought and paid for by the blood of Jesus. Jesus paid the bill for our health and welfare.

**L.** Healing is Jesus' signature.

### 4. MAKE GOD'S WORD FINAL AUTHORITY FOR YOUR HEALING

**A.**

God wants to heal you, not condemn you. Right now there is no condemnation to those who don't live their lives by their five physical senses. We live by God's WORD, and therefore God is not condemning us. This is a spiritual law.

**Romans 8:1-2** There is therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit. 2 For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus hath made me free from the law of sin and death.

**Romans 8:1-2** So now the case is closed. There remains no accusing voice of condemnation against those who are joined in life-union with Jesus, the Anointed One. 2For the "law" of the Spirit of life flowing through the anointing of Jesus has liberated us from the "law" of sin and death. (TPT)

**B.** The law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus has made us free (liberated us) from all parts of the curse.

**C.** The Love of God manifests in you. It's working all the time, bringing healing.

**D.** Say: "Faith is coming, and I am healed!"

**E.**

How many drops of water does it take to overflow a cup? Only one! Faith comes when water is being heated. You watch and keep waiting because it's coming! With the right amount of time and heat, the water boils.

**F.** You can't feel faith; it is a spiritual thing. But as you spend time hearing God's WORD, it will automatically spring up. **G.** Keep

listening to God's WORD, and faith will come. It's a spiritual thing, and when it comes, you are healed!
